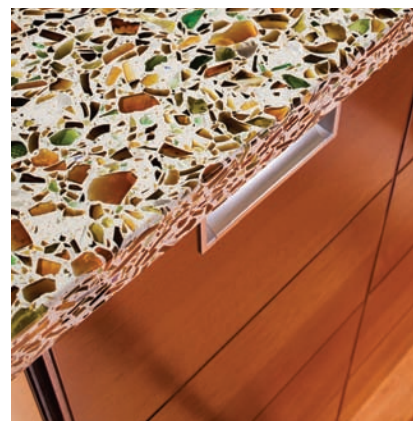

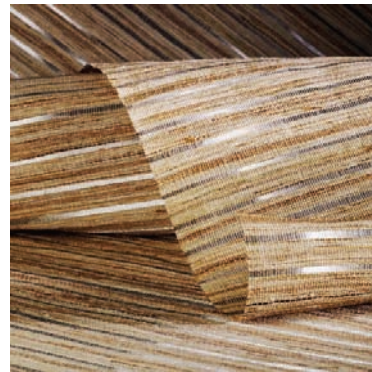
EARTH-FRIENDLY OPTIONS FOR HOME DÉCOR
